

## Strategy 52



## **Uses**:

- To provide writing practice in a casual framework.
- To provide an opportunity for the student to learn from the tutor's model.

- **Procedure:** 1. Explain to the student that you will try to have a conversation on paper. Explain that spelling will not matter for this exercise. The student should just spell the words the way they sound (Strategy 50).
  - 2. Begin by writing a question or comment. Pass the note to your student and ask your student to respond in writing and pass the note back to you.
  - 3. Respond only to the content, as you would in a conversation. Do not correct spelling or other errors unless your student asks a specific question.
  - 4. When possible, incorporate in your responses words that your student has misspelled. Your student might use some of your words as models.
  - 5. Silently note patterns in the student's errors. Use these patterns to determine future spelling exercises.
