

Past (Irregular verbs - negative)
(positive answer expected)

- S. (present) I don't begin to study.
S. (past) I didn't began to study. {begin, began}
Q. Didn't I begin to study?
- S. (present) You don't come to school.
S. (past) You didn't come to school. {come, came}
Q. Didn't you come to school?
- S. (present) He doesn't eat chocolate.
S. (past) He didn't eat chocolate. {eat, ate}
Q. Didn't he eat chocolate?
- S. (present) She doesn't find money.
S. (past) She didn't find money. {find, found}
Q. Didn't she find money?
- S. (present) It doesn't get milk.
S. (past) It didn't get milk. {get, got}
Q. Didn't it get milk?
- S. (present) We don't go home.
S. (past) We didn't go home. {go, went}
Q. Didn't we go home?
- S. (present) You don't have candy.
S. (past) You didn't have candy. {have, had}
Q. Didn't you have candy?
- S. (present) They don't sleep.
S. (past) They didn't sleep. {sleep, slept}
Q. Didn't they sleep?
