S. (present)	I	begin	to study.	
S. (past)	I	began	to study.	{begin, began}
Q.	Did	I	begin	to study?
S. (present)	You	come	to school.	
S. (past)	You	came	to school.	{come, came}
Q.	Did	you	come	to school?
S. (present)	He	eats	chocolate.	
S. (past)	He	ate	chocolate.	{eat, ate}
Q.	Did	he	eat	chocolate?
S. (present)	She	finds	money.	
S. (past)	She	found	money.	{find, found}
Q.	Did	she	find	money?
S. (present)	It	gets	milk.	
S. (past)	It	got	milk.	{get, got}
Q.	Did	it	get	milk?
S. (present)	We	go	home.	
S. (past)	We	went	home.	{go, went}
Q.	Did	we	go	home?
S. (present)	You	have	candy.	
S. (past)	You	had	candy.	{have, had}
Q.	Did	you	have	candy?
S. (present)	They	sleep.		
S. (past)	They	slept.		{sleep, slept}
Q.	Did	they	sleep?
