

Present tense (Regular verb - negative)
(expects positive answer)

S. I don't listen to music.

Q. Don't I listen to music?

S. You don't play the piano.

Q. Don't you play the piano?

S. He doesn't study English.

Q. Doesn't he study English?

S. She doesn't work in Austin.

Q. Doesn't she work in Austin?

S. It doesn't stop raining.

Q. Doesn't it stop raining?

S. We don't watch TV.

Q. Don't we watch TV?

S. You don't look at the book.

Q. Don't you look at the book?

S. They don't clean the room.

Q. Don't they clean the room?
