## Modalverben

Name the six German modal verbs and give the full conjugation to each.

Give the meanings to each.

Be prepared to provide a full German sentence for each - with English translations.

Explain how the grammar & word order operates in sentences containing both a modal & a lexical verb.

Give the meanings to the NEGATED forms of müssen & dürfen.

Provide the full conjugation to the subjunctive form *möchten*.

Explain the difference in meaning between the indicative and the subjunctive of mögen.

(Indicative = mag, magst, mögen, etc. / subjunctive = möchte, möchtest, möchten, etc.)

Write sentences in German (& translations) showing you understand the difference between mögen & möchten.

Notice that some modal verbs can take a direct object with no lexical verb.

(Ich will Wasser. - I want water. / Sie mag Musik. - She likes music.)

Translate sentences from English into German. Examine the website info sheet for explanations & examples.
