spielen	play (a game, an instrument, a sport), goof around
studieren	be enrolled as a student, have a major (<i>ongoing, compare with 'lernen'</i>)
tanzen	dance
tun	do (often interchangeable with 'machen')

wohnen	reside, live, maintain a domicile (<i>compare with 'leben'</i>)
