






ENGLISH LITERATURE AND FRENCH



In Father Nolan's English class we learned to appreciate the beauty of high expression in our own language and the art of producing the same.


In Father Meulemans French class, we learned the language of scholarship which will greatly help us in our later Theological studies.

This is the same corner as in the picture above after everything was finished.







The priest must be a man of prayer. We began and ended our day with prayer in common. Some period during the day was also set aside for our visit to the Blessed Sacrament.





The very central act of our daily spiritual life was the Mass. It kept before our eyes the reason for our vocation, the redemptive act of Christ.


The supreme moment of our assistance at Mass came when we received Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.







